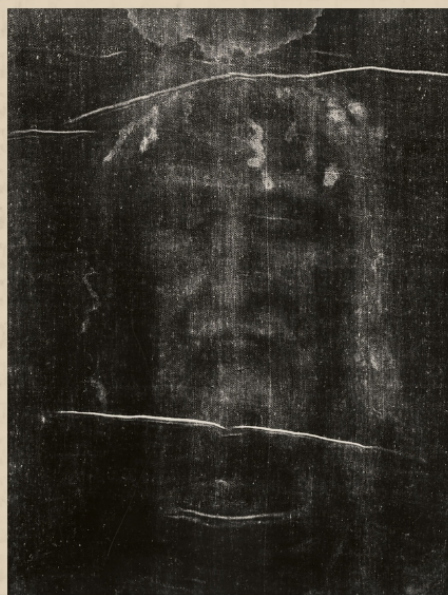


# “LORD, YOU COULD NOT LOVE ME MORE!”

## Saint John Paul II and the Shroud of Turin

NEW EXHIBIT | LENT 2025

This Lent, the Shrine will display an exhibit on the Shroud of Turin, responding to the call of Saint John Paul II for greater understanding and devotion to this precious image. The exhibit traces the movement of the Shroud through history and presents the recent work of Shroud researcher, Dr. Gilbert Lavoie, author of *The Shroud of Jesus: And The Sign John Ingeniously Concealed*. It also features a replica of the Shroud of Turin and a life-size sculpture by Pablo Eduardo of the crucified man of the Shroud based on Dr. Lavoie's observations of the Shroud image.
